Withdrawal of the Wealden Local Plan (2019) under Regulation 27 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

I am writing to inform you that Wealden District Council has withdrawn the Wealden Local Plan from the independent Local Plan examination process. A decision was made by Full Council on the 19th February 2020 following the stage one examination process in May and July 2019 and the Inspector's letter of 20th December 2019. A Full Council report and minutes of the meeting provide full details of the decision, and are available on the Council's website.

The Council will be undertaking further work on a new Local Plan. This Plan will incorporate a full review of the planning policies of Wealden District. This will include consideration of future growth requirements and site allocations.

The Council is required to notify those persons on the Council's Planning Policy database of the withdrawal of the Wealden Local Plan 2019. If your details remain on our database, we will also inform you of any further Local Plan consultations that will take place in the future. In addition, if you still retain publically accessible documents associated with the Wealden Local Plan following on from the Council's depositing of such materials, these will need to be destroyed. If you wish for Wealden District Council to remove such documents, then the Council will be able to assist in this matter providing you reply to this letter confirming this.
