I am back at work today and to answer your question I am enclosing a flyer that have used at other venues. I would expect to be distributing a similar one in the Polegate area once times etc. agreed. Basically the vehicle has been set up to replicate a small version of one of our offices, with internet access, table and chairs and a selection of the literature that we have available. It is intended as an Information and Advice service for those of later life (we do formally work with those aged 50 and over, but would always try and help someone who came to see us that was younger). The sort of information and advice we give is around benefit entitlement, sourcing of qualified and trusted tradespeople, wills and power of attorney, housing problems, avoiding scams. This list is not exhaustive and is something we achieve either in house or by signposting to appropriate support.
